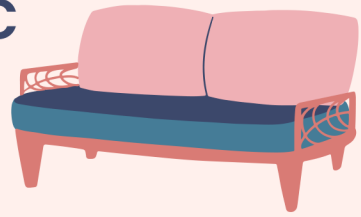


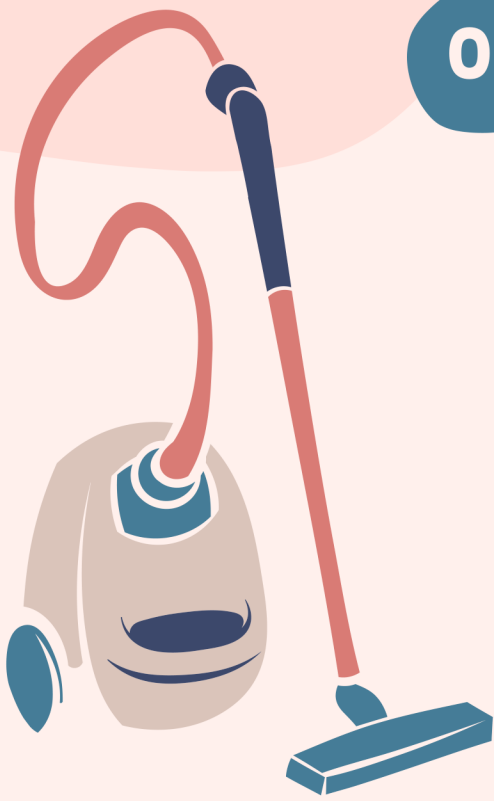
# Ultimate Guide

## To Cleaning Your Fabric Couch

**01**

### PREPARE YOUR MATERIALS

- Vacuum cleaner with upholstery attachment
- Soft bristle brush or microfiber cloth
- Mild dish soap or upholstery cleaner
- Warm water in a spray bottle
- Clean white towels or paper towels
- Optional: Fabric protector spray

### VACUUM THOROUGHLY

- Attach the upholstery attachment to your vacuum cleaner.
- Start by removing loose dirt, crumbs, and debris from the couch.
- Pay special attention to crevices and between cushions.

**03**

### CHECK THE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Consult the manufacturer's instructions or care label on your couch.

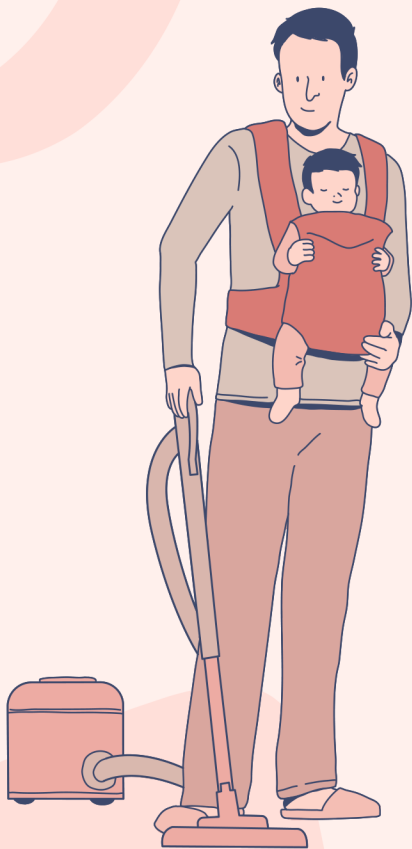
### PERFORM A SPOT TEST

- Gently scrub the fabric using a soft bristle brush or microfiber cloth.
- Wipe away excess moisture with a clean towel, ensuring not to oversaturate.

### ALLOW FOR DRYING TIME

- Open windows or turn on fans to aid in the drying process.
- Avoid sitting or placing any objects on the couch until it is completely dry.
- Drying times may vary based on the fabric type and room temperature.
